

## **Guidelines for use of camp for family gatherings from May 1, 2021 to September 6, 2021:**

1. Open only to Community of Christ families, with families defined as parent(s), guardians and children living under the same roof. Exceptions may be made for grandparents.
2. Limited to four or fewer families at a time staying in tents or hillside cabins (Nos. 1-11) for no more than two nights.
3. Tents must be pitched at least 50' apart. Spaces will be assigned by camp manager.
4. Up to three self contained RV's may also be allowed at the same time. If an RV is not self contained it counts against the limitations in paragraph 2.
5. Reservations must be made at least three weeks in advance.
6. Each family will be assigned one side of a bathhouse.
7. Families must provide their own food. Portable grills are allowed.
8. No open fires permitted and no cooking in cabins.
9. Other than bathhouses and assigned cabins, no buildings or their contents may be used for any purpose.
10. Pool and marching fields are off limits.
11. One family at a time may sign up for playground and basketball court. Playground will be sanitized between uses.
12. No pets allowed.
13. Labyrinth may be used one family at a time.
14. Peace Patio, gazebo and benches at the playground may be used but if more than one family is present masks and social distancing must be used.
15. Wooden picnic tables may be moved to the campsite if desired but must be returned to original location before leaving.
16. Each family is responsible for the cleanup of their own campsite or cabin, including placing trash in the dumpster at the camp garage. Those staying in cabins must clean and sanitize all mattresses, door knobs and other areas assigned by camp manager. Wipes and spray will be provided.
17. Camp managers will clean cabin a/c filters after each use.
18. Utility and sanitizing fees will be charged. RV-\$50 for one or two nights; tents and cabins \$40 for one or two nights.
19. The shelter house may be used for a fire but not for cooking. If more than one family is present masks and social distancing must be used and singing is not allowed. Participants bring their own chairs.
20. Camp Manager has the authority to decline requests for reservations if it would interfere with needed work at the campground.
21. Each family will take daily temperatures. If anyone is running a temperature of 100.4 or higher they will notify the Camp Manager and leave the campground. Campground manager will inform others on the grounds and they may choose to stay or leave, as circumstances indicate.
22. While we encourage Covid vaccinations, having received a vaccine does not provide an exemption from following all guidelines.
23. Families must check the site <https://globalepidemics.org/key-metrics-for-covid-suppression/> for three weeks prior to their scheduled stay at camp. If their county of residence is not in the green or yellow categories (under 10 new Covid cases per 100K of population) for three consecutive weeks they will be unable to come to camp.
24. Anyone camping does so at their own risk.
